

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-1183

AN ORDINANCE DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY POLICE CHIEF TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF RESERVE POLICE OFFICER BY ADMINISTRATIVE RULE, AND REPEALING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 81-1012

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THE DALLES ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authority Delegated. The City Council authorizes the City Police Chief, or his duly authorized designee, to establish the position of reserve police officer, and to create the duties and qualifications for the position, and describe the powers of the position. The Police Chief or his designee shall have the administrative authority to establish the necessary provisions as part of the Police Department's Police Procedure Manual.

Section 2. Repeal. General Ordinance No. 81-1012 is hereby repealed.
