This week the City of The Dalles Public Works Department will continue pavement preservation projects. Due to weather, work on East 12th Street between H Street and Kelly Avenue has been delayed until the week of April 23, 2018.

East 9th Street and East 10th Street between Oregon and Quinton Streets. Transportation crews will patch streets following recent upgrades to the sanitary sewer. **Full road closure from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at this location on April 16, 2018.**

In preparation for chip sealing activities in June 2018, the transportation crews will prepare the street surface in the following locations:

Union Street between 4th Street and 10th Street. No parking zone signs will be placed on Tuesday April 17 ahead of street closures on Wednesday April 18. Motorists are asked to park vehicles outside of the work zone during work hours. **Rolling road closures will move through the pavement restoration project area, moving south to north, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at this location Wednesday April 18.**

West 10th Street between Walnut Street and the bridge east of Cherry Heights Road. No parking zone signs will be placed on Wednesday April 18 ahead of street closures on Thursday April 19. Motorists are asked to park vehicles outside of the work zone during work hours. **Rolling road closures will move through the pavement restoration project area, moving east to west, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at this location Thursday April 19.**

The purpose of these projects is to extend the service life of the pavement structure.

Please proceed with caution in these areas during construction times and observe all temporary traffic control devices. Thank you for your patience during this work.
