QUALIFICATIONS

A candidate must be a registered voter and reside within the City limits at least 12 months immediately before being elected or appointed to office. No person may be a candidate, at a single election, for more than one elective City office.

HOW TO FILE FOR CANDIDACY

FILING BY DECLARATION

Candidates filing by declaration may file the appropriate forms along with a \$25.00 fee, payable to the City of The Dalles.

FILING BY PETITION: Due to COVID -19 there will be no filing by petition in 2020

1. <u>If filing by Declaration:</u> Complete and file form SEL 101, Candidate Filing for Nonpartisan Nomination; pay \$25.00 fee.

Please see Campaign Finance Reporting Section for specific requirements regarding additional forms which may need to be filed.

- 2. <u>Due to COVID 19 The City of The Dalles will not be accepting petitions in 2020</u>
- 3. Last day to file **August 25, 2020 5pm**
- 4. To file a withdrawal of candidacy, Form SEL 150 must be filed with the City Elections Officer no later than 5:00 p.m., August 28, 2018.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTING

Every candidate and prospective candidate is required to establish a candidate committee by opening a campaign account and filing a Statement of Organization (SEL 220) and Campaign Account Information form (SEL 223) within three business days of receiving or spending any money to support the candidacy.

The candidate is **not required** to establish a campaign account, file a Statement of Organization or file contribution and expenditure transactions **if all three** of the following conditions are met:

The candidate serves as their own treasurer **AND**

The candidate does not have an existing candidate committee AND

The candidate does not expect to spend or receive more than \$750 during the calendar year

The \$750 includes personal funds spent for any campaign related costs, such as candidate filing fee. If at any time during a calendar year the candidate exceeds \$750 in contributions or expenditures, the candidate must establish a campaign account and file form SEL 220 within three business days of exceeding the \$750 threshold.

A candidate that does not expect to receive or spend a total of more than \$3,500 for the calendar year may qualify to file a Certificate of Limited Contributions and Expenditures. See the Campaign Finance Manual for detailed information on filing a certificate.

All contribution and expenditure reports are filed directly with the Secretary of State, Elections Division through their ORESTAR system.
